## **Rapid Bay Jetty Update**

13<sup>th</sup> December 2007

The Friends of Rapid Bay Jetty have contacted the Department of Transport, Energy & Infrastructure to find out the latest news on the new jetty at Rapid Bay. The project managers from DTEI have provided the following update:

*“Bardavcol presented the results of the geotechnical investigation to DTEI earlier this week. The report is considered to provide all of the necessary information for the short listed companies to undertake the final design and costing for the project. DTEI plan to have the information to the two companies in the near future so they can prepare final designs and quotes to undertake the work. These tenders will be assessed and the project awarded to the successful company. This is expected to take several months but we still hope to have work underway on site before the middle of the year and completed for the target date of the end of 2008.*”

*At this stage DTEI will not be undertaking any work at Rapid Bay over the summer so the site will be available for divers and anglers [including on the existing jetty up to the safety barrier].”*

The Friends of Rapid Bay Jetty would like to thank those who signed the petition & lobbied to achieve the results to date. This time next year, we'll be walking down a new jetty at Rapid Bay!
